Muscular Dystrophy is a progressive neuromuscular genetic disorder where the afflicted persons gradually lose their muscular strength leading to complete immobility and become dependent on others for everyday activities . In India every year than 4000 children are born with muscular dystrophy. Muscular dystrophy comes under the category of rare diseases and treatment of such disease is very costly and rare available.

SJVN Foundation under its CSR initiative has supported Indian Association of Muscular Dystrophy (IAMD) for construction of Manav Mandir- an Integrated Muscular Dystrophy Centre at Solan in Himachal Pradesh. The institute consists of indoor treatment, specialized doctors, para medical staffs, physiotherapy, aqua therapy, research facilities etc. The Institute has been inaugurated in the year 2018 by his Excellency, Governor of H.P. Sh. Acharya Dev Vrat in the benign presence of CMD, SJVN, Sh. Nand Lal Sharma and the other dignitaries of Govt. of HP and SJVN. The Institution is running successfully and serving the afflicted persons coming across the country.
