PM INAUGURATED FIRST UNIT OF STPL's 1320 MW BTTP IN BIHAR

In a major push for sustainable development, industrial growth and infrastructure enhancement, Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi inaugurated and laid the foundation stone of multiple Projects in Bihar worth over Rs. 13 Thousand Crores from Bodh Gaya. On this historic moment, Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi virtually inaugurated First Unit (660 MW) of 1320 MW (2x660MW) Buxar Thermal Power Project. The ceremony was attended by Hon'ble Governor of Bihar, Shri Arif Mohammed Khan, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Bihar, Shri Nitish Kumar, Union Ministers, Deputy Chief Ministers of Bihar,

State Ministers and other prominent dignitaries. The event was also attended by Shri Pankaj Agarwal, Secretary (Power), Ministry of Power, Shri Bhupender Gupta, CMD, SJVN, Shri Ajay Kumar Sharma, Director (Personnel), Shri Vikas Sharma, CEO of STPL and other senior officials of SJVN. Employees of SJVN and its subsidiaries across all Projects and Units in India and Nepal witnessed this historic occasion through live streaming. 1320 MW (2x660 MW) Buxar Thermal Power Project located at Chausa in District Buxar, Bihar is being implemented by SJVN Thermal Private Limited, a wholly-owned subsidiary of SJVN. The foundation stone of the Project





was laid by Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi on 9th March 2019. Equipped with state-of-the-art super critical technology, the Project ensures higher efficiency and reduced environmental impact. With the total investment of Rs. 13,756.56 Crore, the project will generate 9,828.72 Million Units of electricity annually, out of which 85% power has been allocated to Bihar under a long-term Power Purchase Agreement. The Project will substantially enhance power availability in Bihar and the Eastern Region, reducing peak-hour shortages and strengthening energy security. Its construction involved the use of around 2,54,932 MT of steel and 2,80,362 tonnes of cement, providing a significant boost to the vision of Atmanirbhar Bharat by promoting domestic

industries. During construction phase, the Project engaged nearly 5,000 workers annually, with local residents being the primary beneficiaries. It has created both direct and indirect employment opportunities, which will continue during its operational phase as well. Local markets, small businesses, hotels and transport services have also experienced growth, contributing to the region's economic development. Additionally, SJVN has actively undertaken community development initiatives in education, healthcare, sanitation, drinking water, and women empowerment, thereby ensuring inclusive growth and long-term social impact. First unit (660 MW) of the 1320 MW Buxar Thermal Power Project has been successfully synchronized with National Grid on 21.08.2025.

PM LAID FOUNDATION STONE OF 200 MW SOLAR POWER PROJECT (GUVNL PHASE – XVII, KHAVDA SOLAR PARK)



In a proud moment for SJVN Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi virtually laid the foundation stone of 200 MW Solar Power Project (GUVNL Phase–XVII, Khavda Solar Park) at Khavda, Gujarat. This historic occasion was graced by, Chief Minister of Gujarat Shri Bhupendrabhai Patel, Union Minister of Ports, Shipping and Waterways, Shri Sarbananda Sonowal, Union Minister of Labour and Employment and Youth Affairs and Sports, Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya, Union Minister of Jal Shakti, Shri Chandrakant Raghunath Patil, Union MoS Ports, Shipping and Waterways, Shri Shantanu Thakur, Union MoS Consumer Affairs, Food and Public Distribution, Smt. Nimuben Jayantibhai Bambhaniya and other dignitaries. The event was virtually joined by CMD SJVN Shri Bhupender Gupta, Director (Personnel) Shri Ajay Kumar Sharma, Director (Finance) Shri Sipan Kumar Garg, CEO, SGEL, Shri Ajay Singh and senior officials of SJVN and SGEL. 200 MW Khavda Solar Power Project is situated in Khavda Solar Park being developed by Gujarat State Electricity Corporation Limited (GSECL) in Kachchh District of Gujarat. The Power generated

from the Project will be supplied to Gujarat Urja Vikas Nigam Limited (GUVNL) for 25 Years at a tariff of Rs. 2.88/ Unit. The Project will be built at an estimated cost of about ₹866.8 Crore. It is expected to generate 504.92 million units of electricity in the first year and a cumulative 11,620 million units over a period of 25 years. Additionally, the Project is anticipated to reduce carbon emissions by about 5,69,250 tonnes over 25 years. The Project is scheduled to be commissioned by 31st December 2026. The installation of this Project will contribute to India's commitment towards achieving 500 GW of renewable energy capacity by 2030 and Net Zero emissions by 2070. It will also create direct and indirect employment opportunities in the region. Moreover, the Project will utilize the vast arid land of Kachchh for clean power generation and help meet the renewable energy requirements of Gujarat. SJVN has commissioned fourteen Projects with a total installed capacity of 2968 MW and 123 km of transmission lines. The company is currently operating and implementing power projects across India and in the neighbouring country of Nepal.

37th ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING

SJVN held its 37th Annual General Meeting (AGM) on 25th September 2025. Chairman & Managing Director, Shri Bhupender Gupta addressed the shareholders and outlined operational, financial and strategic achievements of the company in FY 2024–25. In his address, Sh. Bhupender Gupta said that FY 2024–25 was a defining year of operational excellence. SJVN achieved its highest-ever generation of 10,647 MU from all operational projects. The 1500 MW Nathpa Jhakri Hydro Power Station delivered record outputs, including highest ever quarterly generation of 3450.98 MU, highest single-day generation of 39.572 MU and record monthly generation of 1222.170 MU. Similarly, 412 MW Rampur Hydro Power Station achieved its highest-ever monthly generation of 292.331 MU and clocked record quarterly generation of 955.616 MU, along with highest single-day generation of 11.023 MU. The 60 MW Naitwar Mori Hydro Power Station surpassed its design energy and generated 316.40 MU in its first operational year. Sh. Bhupender Gupta stated that SJVN has reported robust financial results in FY 2024–25. Revenue from Operations increased to ₹2,897.25 crore, up by ₹363.66 crore from ₹2,533.59 crore in FY 2023–24. Standalone Profit After Tax (PAT) also increased to ₹970.18 crore, up by ₹61.78 crore from ₹908.40 crore in previous year. The Board of the company has recommended final dividend of ₹0.31 per share, taking total dividend for FY 2024–25 to ₹1.46 per share including interim dividend. The company maintained one of the healthiest receivables ratios in the sector, achieving best-ever trade receivables level of 15 days of revenue, reflecting strong financial discipline. FY



2024-25 was marked with landmark achievement of prestigious Navratna status on 30th August, 2024. This milestone reflects SJVN's operational excellence, financial strength and importance in India's power sector transformation. Since April 2024, 691 MW capacity has been added taking total installed capacity portfolio to 2967.52 MW from 12 projects. The first unit of 660 MW of Buxar Thermal Power Project has been successfully synchronized with national grid on 21st August 2025 and was inaugurated by Hon'ble Prime Minister on 22nd August 2025. In FY 2024–25, SJVN incurred an expenditure of ₹31.24 crore on Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) with initiatives in verticals such as health, education, livelihood creation and community infrastructure development etc. Retaining an 'Excellent' Corporate governance rating under DPE, company continues to advance its projects to cut carbon emissions and support India's clean energy transition. For FY 2025–26, SJVN has an MOU target of 13090 MU generation and ₹12,000 crore Capex. During Q1 of the fiscal, company has reported energy generation of 3681.60 MU, recorded revenue of ₹822.4 crore and PAT of ₹258.51 crore. Concluding his address, Sh. Bhupender Gupta extended heartfelt gratitude to Government of India, State Governments, key Ministries and partner institutions for their continued guidance and support. He also thanked all stakeholders and lauded the dedication of Board and SJVN employees as true strength of company. Reaffirming SJVN's commitment to excellence and sustainable growth, he emphasized its role in building Viksit and Shreshtha Bharat.

As a seasoned speaker on Accounting Standards and Ind AS, he has shared his insights widely over the years. 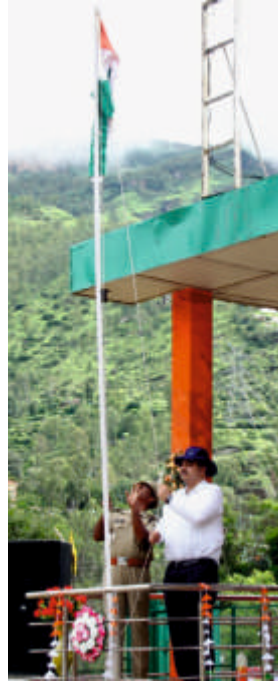
1500 मेगावॉट, नाथपा झाकड़ी जल विद्युत स्टेशन

210 मेगावॉट, लूहरी जल विद्युत परियोजना, चरण-1



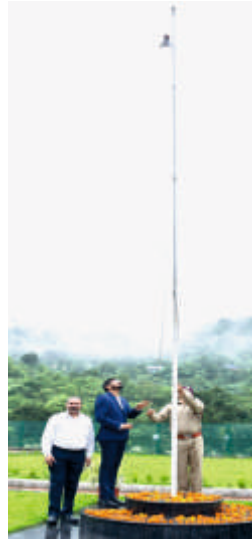
