2.	RFS	6.6.4	CONNECTIVITY WITH THE GRID AT INTERCONNECTI ON POINT/DELIVERY POINTS:	The WPD shall be required to follow provisions of the RfS, PPA and PSA. The Bidders are free to choose the ISTS substations for Interconnection of the Project to the Grid on pan-India basis. Bidder must have secured final grant of connectivity at their identified ISTS substation with start date of connectivity by 31.05.2026 along with SCOD of the Associated Transmission System (ATS)/Augmentation as required, as on the last date of bid submission.	The WPD shall be required to follow provisions of the RfS, PPA and PSA. The Bidders are free to choose the ISTS substations for Interconnection of the Project to the Grid on a pan-India basis preferably in India. While doing so, the Bidders shall apply due diligence while choosing the proposed substation, and may choose their substations from any one of the following options: - Existing substations having available margin as indicated by the respective substation owner. - Existing substations/ substations under construction where augmentation is under process or plans for augmentation have been announced. - Substations approved under the updated plan made available by the CTU on its website, subject to availability of requisite margin for grant of connectivity. Bids indicating substations outside the above three choices will be liable for rejection. Note: In case Bidder has already secured connectivity at any substation (s) specified under Clause 6.6.4, bid indicating such substation(s) shall also be considered.
3.	RFS	6.6.9	CONNECTIVITY WITH THE GRID AT INTERCONNECTI ON POINT/DELIVERY POINTS:	The WPD has to follow the timelines mentioned in the GNA regulation with respect to Connectivity. In case, connectivity has been revoked due to non-compliance of WPD, then the same may be considered as WPD's Event of Default and shall be dealt as per the provision of PPA / RfS.	The WPDs will be required to apply for connectivity at the identified substation, as mentioned in the Covering Letter (Format 7.1), within 30 days of Signing of PPA(s), and shall furnish copies of the application, complete in all respect, to SJVN within 15 days of date of filing of application. WPD shall also have to provide the copy of in-principle grant of connectivity, final grant of connectivity, connectivity agreement/any other agreement(s) signed with STU/CTU etc. within 15 days of issuance of letter by CTU / signing of connectivity agreement, as the case may be, to SJVN. The WPD has to follow the timelines mentioned in the GNA regulation with respect to Connectivity. In case, connectivity has been revoked due to non-compliance of WPD, then the same may be considered as WPD's Event of Default and shall be dealt as per the provision of PPA / RfS.

Provided that any extension in SCSD on account of such change (s) in configuration / delivery point / project location shall not be granted. SJVN shall not be responsible for any delay----- ----- -----	The Wind project location/configuration will be submitted by the bidder at the time of bid submission, and it shall remain unchanged until the issuance of LoA. However, the successful bidder shall have option to change the Project location before the Financial Closure. Also, any change in delivery point(s) is /are allowed up to Financial Closure of the Project. i) In this regard, any change in Delivery Point from the one mentioned in the Covering Letter at the time of bid submission shall be allowed till the deadline to apply for connectivity. However, if the PSA for the project is already signed, any such change in Delivery Point shall be allowed with the consent of the DISCOM(s). ii) Subsequent to lapse of the deadline to apply for connectivity, any change in Delivery Point shall be allowed by SJVN only in case the scheduled commissioning date of the ISTS-substation of the proposed revised Delivery Point is on or before the scheduled commissioning date of the existing Delivery Point of the Project, at the time of seeking approval from SJVN by the WPD. In this case, the WPD will be required to apply for connectivity at the proposed substation within 7 working days of intimation of approval for the same by SJVN. In case the WPD fails to obtain connectivity on account of reasons attributable to it, including but not limited to failure to apply for connectivity within the above deadline, the WPD will not be eligible for corresponding extension in the timelines for meeting the Project milestones. In case of change in Project location(s)/delivery point by the WPD, extension requests under this clause shall be dealt by SJVN on case-to-case basis.
