## SJVN's NJHPS ACHIEVED HISTORIC MILESTONE OF 150 BILLION UNITS (BU) OF CUMULATIVE POWER GENERATION



**S**JVN's Nathpa Jhakri Hydro Power Station (NJHPS) achieved historic milestone of 150 Billion Units (BU) of cumulative power generation. NJHPS, the nation's largest underground hydro power station, crossed this landmark on 9th March 2026, reaffirming its significant contribution to clean energy generation and strengthening the national power grid. To mark the occasion, celebrations were held at the Power House in the august presence of Sh. Bhupender Gupta, Chairman & Managing Director and Sh. Ajay Kumar Sharma, Director (Personnel). Senior officials of SJVN were also present on the occasion. Speaking at the event, Sh. Bhupender Gupta highlighted that since its commissioning in May 2004, NJHPS has consistently demonstrated exceptional operational reliability. "It has emerged as a cornerstone of the northern power grid, delivering dependable green energy and



ensuring grid stability during peak demand periods," he stated. He further apprised that the performance of NJHPS has been marked by several notable benchmarks. NJHPS achieved its highest-ever annual generation of 7,610.257 million units in FY 2011-12, followed by a record monthly generation of 1,222.170 million units in July 2024. The highest-ever daily generation of 39.572 million units,



recorded on 13 August 2024, further reflects its capability to optimally harness favorable hydrological conditions. 150 BU milestone carries significant environmental value, representing the displacement of large volumes of fossil-fuel-based generation and the consequent reduction in greenhouse gas emissions. The station thus remains integral to India's clean energy transition and climate commitments. Operated by SJVN, NJHPS continues to benefit from

systematic modernization, digital monitoring, and rigorous maintenance practices. Beyond power generation, the project has contributed to regional socio-economic development through employment creation and infrastructure growth. As India advances towards an expanded renewable energy portfolio, the achievement of SJVN stands as a testament to engineering excellence and the strategic importance of hydropower in the country at large.

## SH. PARTHAJIT DE ASSUMED CHARGE OF DIRECTOR (FINANCE) IN SJVN

His wide-ranging experience includes a strong understanding of Indian Accounting Standards, taxation laws, tariff regulations, and

corporate governance, which play a critical role in the planning, development and operation of power sector projects. Sh. Parthajit De has served at several Project locations including Rangit Project (Sikkim), Teesta Low Dam Projects (West Bengal), Siang Basin Projects (Arunachal Pradesh) and Rural Roads Project (Bihar). He also headed the Committee for first-time adoption of Indian Accounting Standards (Ind AS) in NHPC. He is a Fellow Member of the Institute of Cost Accountants of India (ICMAI) and also holds the Chartered Financial Analyst and CGMA qualifications.



## HIGHEST-EVER GENERATION OF 2098.03 MILLION UNITS AT RAMPUR, HPS



**O**n March 26, 2026, 412 MW Rampur Hydro Power Station at Himachal Pradesh has surpassed its Highest-Ever Generation of 2098.03 million units, previously recorded during FY 2019-20. Sh. Ajay Kumar Sharma, Director (Personnel), SJVN witnessed surpassing of previous generation record during his visit to the Power House of Rampur HPS. During his visit, Sh. Sharma interacted with the team of O&M, appreciated their dedication and commitment. He congratulated everyone and stated that such milestones are result of consistent hard work and dedication for excellence. He exhorted Project employees to continue striving for even greater achievements in future. Sh. Vikas Marwah, Head of Project, Rampur HPS dedicated this achievement to the visionary leadership & unwavering support of the SJVN Management and teamwork & relentless efforts of all

employees. On the occasion of this achievement, Sh. Rajeev Kapoor, HOP, NJHPS and Sh. Vivek Sharma, HOP, LHEP-1 along with senior officials were also present. Since its commissioning, Rampur HPS has consistently demonstrated exceptional performance, setting multiple benchmarks in power generation. The Power Station has already achieved its Design Energy target of 1,878 million units for FY 2025-26 on December 8, 2025, marking its fastest achievement since commissioning. Also SJVN has achieved a significant milestone as its 412 MW Rampur Hydro Power Station recorded fastest-ever generation of 2000 Million Units in a FY on February 5, 2026. The achievement was accomplished nine days ahead of previous record set on February 14, 2020, marking best generation performance of the Power Station in last eleven years of operation.

This solar installation is in addition to the 172 kWp Solar Rooftop PV Plant already installed at Rampur HPS Colony and the 60 kWp Solar Plant at the Valve House, thereby significantly enhancing the green energy footprint of Rampur HPS. During the visit, the Chairman & Managing Director and Director (Personnel) also planted saplings at the project site as a symbolic gesture towards promoting environmental conservation and sustainability. ## ACHIEVEMENTS

### SJVN ACHIEVED COD OF 70 MW DHUBRI SOLAR POWER PROJECT IN ASSAM

**S**JVN has successfully achieved Commercial Operation Date (COD) of 70 MW Dhubri Solar Power Project in Assam on 5th February 2026. The project has been executed through wholly owned subsidiary, SJVN Green Energy Limited (SGEL) marking another significant milestone in company's renewable energy journey. The 70 MW Dhubri Solar Power Project has been developed on 330 acres of lease-based land located at Village Khudigaon Pt. II, District Dhubri, Assam, at project cost of Rs. 367.44 crores. The Project is expected to generate 141.13 million units of electricity in its first year of



operation and approximately 3,230 million units cumulatively over a period of 25 years. The maximum usage charges for the project have been fixed at Rs 3.92 per unit, ensuring supply of affordable and clean power. The generated power will be supplied to Assam Power Distribution Company Limited (APDCL). The foundation stone of this project was laid by the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, Sh. Narendra Modi, on March 4, 2024, from Adilabad, Telangana.

This Project is first large-scale solar project in the state of Assam and also SJVN first operational project in North Eastern Region.

### CM PEMA KHANDU REVIEWED PROGRESS OF SJVN HYDRO PROJECTS IN DIBANG VALLEY

**H**on'ble Chief Minister of Arunachal Pradesh, Sh. Pema Khandu, Deputy Chief Minister Sh. Chowna Mein and Cabinet Ministers, held Hydro Coordination Meeting at Etalin while on a visit to Dibang Valley District on 2nd February 2026. During the meeting, SJVN's Hydro Projects under implementation in Arunachal Pradesh were reviewed in detail. Head of Project of Etalin, Emini, Amulin & Mihumdon HEPs Sh. Shiraj Swan and Head of Project of Attunli HEP Sh. Shiv Prasad, presented comprehensive status report on land acquisition and compensation, challenges encountered due to terrain and logistics and planned next-phase

## SJVN SIGNED AGREEMENT WITH BHEL FOR 382 MW SUNNI DAM HYDRO POWER PROJECT

**S**JVN has entered to a Contract Agreement with M/s BHEL for Electro-Mechanical Works of 382 MW Sunni Dam Hydro Electric Project worth Rs. 837.43 Crores. The contract agreement was signed in benign presence of Sh. Ajay Kumar Sharma, Director (Personnel), SJVN by Sh. Ravi Rajan, Executive Director (ECD), SJVN and Sh. Ritu Raj, Sr. DGM, M/s BHEL. On this occasion, senior officials of SJVN & M/s BHEL were also present. Sh. Ajay Kumar Sharma apprised that Electro-Mechanical works amounting to Rs. 837.43 Crores were awarded

to BHEL on January 1, 2026 and are scheduled for completion in line with project commissioning timeline by July 31, 2029. Civil and Hydro-Mechanical works, awarded earlier in January 2023, are already progressing at full pace. Sunni Dam Hydro Electric Project is a run-off river scheme with diurnal storage and Dam-Toe surface Power House in Shimla and Kullu Districts of Himachal Pradesh. Project is expected to generate 1381.77 million units of clean electricity annually, strengthening India's renewable energy landscape.

## SJVN FOUNDATION POWERS GRASSROOTS FIGHT AGAINST TUBERCULOSIS IN HIMACHAL PRADESH

In quiet hills of Solan district in Himachal Pradesh, a silent transformation is underway—one that brings together technology, community leadership, and corporate responsibility to combat one of India's most persistent public health challenges: tuberculosis (TB). At the heart of this transformation is the SJVN Foundation, the CSR arm of SJVN Limited, which has taken a decisive step towards strengthening rural healthcare infrastructure. In the financial year 2025–26, SJVN Foundation extended financial support of ₹8.96 lakh for the procurement and installation of a TruNAAT Duo Workstation at Civil Hospital, Chail in Solan district. TruNAAT machine is a portable, chip-based molecular diagnostic system capable of delivering rapid and highly accurate TB test results. For remote and semi-urban areas like Chail, where access to advanced diagnostic facilities has traditionally been limited, this technology is proving to be a game changer. By bringing high-end testing closer to communities, SJVN Foundation has effectively reduced the distance between suspicion and diagnosis—often the most critical gap in TB control. Parallel to this technological intervention, an innovative, competition-based model has been implemented across 240 Panchayats in Solan district. These grassroots governance bodies have been trained and mobilized to take ownership of TB management in their communities. The results have been remarkable. In the first year, 48 Panchayats achieved TB-free status,



earning Bronze recognition. By the second year, 12 Panchayats sustained their performance, progressing to Silver level—demonstrating that consistent effort and community ownership yield tangible outcomes. A key insight from the initiative has been the critical role of laboratory accessibility. Statistical analysis shows that proximity to testing facilities—within a 5 km radius—significantly improves TB detection and management outcomes. This is where SJVN Foundation's intervention becomes pivotal. The installation of the TruNAAT workstation has not only enhanced diagnostic capacity but also strengthened the entire ecosystem of TB care—supporting early detection, timely treatment, and better monitoring. SJVN Foundation's contribution goes beyond a one-time infrastructure investment. It reflects a broader vision of community-centric development, where corporate resources empower local institutions to deliver lasting change. The initiative aligns seamlessly with India's national goal of TB elimination, while also setting a replicable model for other regions. In the fight against tuberculosis, this model offers not just hope—but a roadmap.
