HON'BLE PRIME MINISTER INAUGURATED SJVN's 1000 MW BIKANER SOLAR POWER PROJECT



In a landmark achievement for India's renewable energy sector, Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Modi inaugurated SJVN's 1000 MW Bikaner Solar Power Project from Pachpadra, Rajasthan, on 4 July 2026. The inauguration marks a major milestone in SJVN's clean energy journey and reinforces the nation's commitment towards achieving its renewable energy and sustainability goals. The prestigious event was graced by Hon'ble Governor of Rajasthan, Shri Haribhau Kisanrao Bagde, Chief Minister of Rajasthan, Shri Bhajan Lal Sharma, Union Minister of Power and Housing & Urban Affairs, Shri Manohar Lal, Union Minister of Petroleum and Natural Gas, Shri Hardeep Singh Puri, Union Minister of State (Independent Charge) for Law & Justice and Minister of State for Parliamentary Affairs, Shri Arjun Ram Meghwal, Deputy Chief Minister, Smt. Diya Kumari, Deputy Chief Minister, Dr. Prem Chand Bairwa, along with several other dignitaries. The programme was virtually attended by Shri Bhupender Gupta, Chairman & Managing Director, SJVN, Shri Ajay Kumar Sharma, Director (Personnel), Shri Parthajit De, Director (Finance), Shri Rajesh Kumar Chandel, Director (Projects), Shri Pankaj Porwal, Chief Vigilance Officer, Shri Prashant Sharma, Chief Executive Officer, SJVN Green Energy Limited (SGEL) and senior officials of SJVN and SGEL. Developed by SJVN Green Energy Limited (SGEL), the renewable energy subsidiary of SJVN, 1000 MW

Bikaner Solar Power Project has been established in Bikaner, Rajasthan with an investment of approximately ₹5,492 crore. Spread across nearly 5,000 acres, it is India's largest single-location Engineering, Procurement and Construction (EPC) solar project under the Domestic Content Requirement (DCR) category, reflecting the country's growing capabilities in indigenous renewable energy infrastructure. The project is expected to generate approximately 2,454.84 million units (MU) of electricity during its first year of operation and about 56,482.14 MU of clean energy over its estimated operational life of 25 years. The generated power will be supplied to the States of Rajasthan (500 MW), Uttarakhand (200 MW) and Jammu & Kashmir (300 MW), thereby strengthening the national clean energy grid and ensuring a reliable supply of sustainable power to these regions. The environmental benefits of the project are equally significant. Over its operational life, the project is expected to reduce nearly 2.79 billion kilograms of carbon emissions, making a substantial contribution towards India's climate commitments and its transition to a low-carbon economy. One of the defining feature of the project is its strong alignment with the Government of India's 'Make in India' and 'Atmanirbhar Bharat' initiatives. The solar park has been developed using approximately 24.22 lakh domestically manufactured DCR solar modules and nearly 17.5 crore indigenous solar cells, thereby strengthening the domestic

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manufacturing ecosystem and promoting self-reliance in the renewable energy sector. - project has emerged as a catalyst for regional socio-economic development. During its construction and commissioning phases, it generated over 2,000 direct and indirect employment

opportunities, while it will continue to support local livelihoods during the operational phase. The project has also led to the development of critical infrastructure, including roads, transmission systems and associated facilities, contributing to the overall economic growth of the Bikaner region.

SJVN SIGNED LONG-TERM POWER PURCHASE AGREEMENTS WITH GUVNL FOR THREE HYDRO PROJECTS



SJVN has further strengthened its clean energy portfolio by signing Power Purchase Agreements (PPAs) with Gujarat Urja Vikas Nigam Limited (GUVNL) for sale of electricity from its upcoming hydroelectric projects in Himachal Pradesh. These agreements cover power from 66 MW Dhaulasidh Hydro Electric Project, 210 MW Luhri Stage-I Hydro Electric Project, and 382 MW Sunni Dam Hydro Electric Project. The long-term PPAs mark another significant milestone in

SJVN's commitment to providing reliable and sustainable clean energy to the nation. The agreements were signed at Vadodara, Gujarat, by Sh. Aman Katoch, General Manager (Commercial & Sales Operations), SJVN and Sh. Sanjay Mathur, General Manager (Commerce), GUVNL, in the presence of senior officials from both organizations. The signing of these agreements reinforces SJVN's growing portfolio of long-term power sale arrangements with leading power distribution utilities across the country.

SH. RAJESH KUMAR CHANDEL ASSUMED CHARGE AS DIRECTOR (PROJECTS), SJVN

Sh. Rajesh Kumar Chandel has assumed charge as Director (Projects) SJVN at Company's Liaison Office in New Delhi on 11th June 2026. Prior to assuming the new role, Sh. Chandel was serving as Officer on Special Duty (OSD) to the CMD, SJVN. Earlier, he successfully led SJVN's operations in Nepal as the Chief Executive Officer of SJVN Arun-3 Power Development Company Pvt. Ltd. (SAPDC) and SJVN Lower Arun Power Development Company Pvt. Ltd. (SLPDC). Since October 2025, he has been steering the development of the 900 MW Arun-3 Hydro Electric Project and the 669 MW Lower Arun Hydro Electric Project, two strategically important hydroelectric projects being executed by SJVN in Nepal.

Among his notable achievements, Sh. Chandel served as Managing Director and Member Secretary of the Punatsangchhu Hydro Electric Power Authority (PHPA-II), Bhutan, where he played a pivotal role in the commissioning of the 1020 MW Punatsangchhu Hydro Electric Project. In 2020, as Head of Project, he led the 66 MW Dhaulasidh Hydro Electric Project from the conceptual stage to

construction, showcasing his capability in delivering challenging infrastructure projects. His association with SJVN spans over three decades. He made significant contributions to the construction of the Head Race Tunnel of the 1500 MW Nathpa Jhakri Hydro Power Station, one of India's landmark hydroelectric projects, where he worked for nearly eight years. At the



Corporate Headquarters, he has held several important assignments in the Corporate Monitoring & Coordination Department, Corporate Facility Management Department and the Office of Director (Civil), contributing to the organization's operational excellence and project management capabilities. Sh. Chandel began his professional career with Himachal Pradesh

Urban Development Authority (HIMUDA) in 1990 and joined SJVN on 5 May 1994. Born on 14 September 1971 in Mahre village of Hamirpur district, Himachal Pradesh, he holds a Bachelor's Degree in Civil Engineering and a Master of Business Administration (MBA). He is a Fellow of The Institution of Engineers (India) and is also a Chartered Engineer, reflecting his strong professional credentials.

SECRETARY (POWER) REVIEWED PROGRESS OF SJVN'S 900 MW ARUN-3 HYDROELECTRIC PROJECT IN NEPAL



Shri Pankaj Agarwal, Secretary (Power), Government of India, visited SJVN's prestigious 900 MW Arun-3 Hydroelectric Project in Nepal on 16th July 2026 to review the progress of this strategically important cross-border hydropower venture. The project is being developed by SJVN through its wholly owned subsidiary, SJVN Arun-3 Power Development Company (SAPDC), and represents a landmark milestone in the growing energy partnership between India and Nepal. The Secretary (Power) was accompanied by a high-level delegation comprising Shri Naveen Srivastava, Ambassador of India to Nepal, Shri Ghanashyam Prasad, Chairperson, Central Electricity Authority (CEA), Shri Diwakar Nath Misra, Additional Secretary (Hydro), Ministry of Power, Shri Pankaj Kumar, Joint Secretary (Transmission), Ministry of Power, Shri Rajesh Kumar Chandel, Director (Projects), SJVN, along with senior officials from the Ministry of Power, Government of India, Embassy of India in Nepal, Central Electricity Authority, SJVN and SAPDC.
